Agricultural Scholarship Information & Guidelines

1. Two scholarships will be awarded annually and announced during the Cherokee Junior Livestock Show.
2. Each scholarship recipient will be awarded the sum of \$1000.00 in tuition assistance during the first year of post-secondary education.
3. Both scholarship opportunities are available to any graduating senior who is currently entered as second-year (or more) exhibitor in the current Cherokee County Jr. Stock Show and plans to attend a post-secondary school and pursue a career in agriculture.
4. Eligibility criteria for this scholarship are:
 - A. Scholarship - - the applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better (excluding health, phys. ed., music or art) at the end of the first semester of his/her senior year.
 - B. Character - - the applicant must be of high moral character.
 - C. Leadership - - the applicant must exhibit good leadership qualities. (4-H, FFA officer, etc.)
 - D. Agricultural Interest - - the applicant must have been entered and participated as an exhibitor in at least two (2) Cherokee County Junior Stock Shows, including the current year.
5. All monies will be paid directly to the college or institute of higher learning designated by the recipient pending enrollment verification.
6. The recipients of each scholarship will be selected by a person or persons designated by the board of directors of the Cherokee County Stock Show & Exposition, Inc.
