

Exceptional Kids Livestock Show

This livestock show will showcase the talents of special need individuals across Cherokee County. Participants will be paired up with their 4-H/FFA show buddy to exhibit their animal and walk away with the pride of knowing they can succeed in the show ring.

Q: What animals will be used?

A: FFA and 4-H buddies will volunteer their animals (goats, lambs, rabbits, pigs) for the purpose of the show. This will provide the buddy valuable community service experience, as well as the honor of helping the exhibitor be a part of something as special as the Cherokee County Junior Livestock Show.

Q: What will exhibitors receive?

A: Every exhibitor will be awarded a blue rosette ribbon and a t-shirt. They will also have the opportunity to have their photograph taken with the animal in front of the Cherokee County Junior Livestock Show backdrop.

Q: Does the exhibitor have to be a FFA or 4-H member?

A: No, the exhibitor does not have to be a member of any chapter/club.

Q: What paperwork will be required?

A: Liability releases are a standard for all exhibitors involved in the Cherokee County Junior Livestock Show and will be used for this event. Other paperwork would include entry forms for the participants and volunteers. These entry forms are available online.
